It is the largest organization of human factors professionals in the world. Since its formation in 1957, the Human Factors and Ergonomics Society has promoted the discovery and exchange of human factors knowledge, as well as education and training for students and practitioners.

What Is Human Factors?

Human factors, also known as ergonomics, is the discovery of principles concerning human capabilities and limitations and the application of those principles to products and systems that people use.

Human factors practitioners apply their skills to a wide variety of products, jobs, and systems. Many develop principles for designing computer hardware and software; others focus on aerospace systems, communication, training, transportation, military systems, consumer products, and medical devices.
