



Abstract Template for 17th Triennial Congress of the International Ergonomics Association (IEA 2009)

ABSTRACT

The purpose of this template is to standardize the preparation and submission of abstracts for review by the International Scientific Committee of the IEA 2009 Congress. The abstract should be written in English, about 500 words, and includes the following information: (1) title, (2) author's name(s), (3) author's affiliation(s), (4) the body text, (5) keywords, and (6) the corresponding author telephone and email. The font for writing the abstract is Times New Roman, as used in this template. The font size varies for the title, author name, affiliation and body text. Follow the given instructions consistently.

Write the abstract title 5 cm from the top edge of the paper. Centre the title, and it should not exceed 15 cm wide (if longer, use a second line). Use **14 point, bold, regular** type for the title, and capital letter for the first word. Leave a space (18 point) after the title. Centre the author name(s) and affiliation(s) below the title. Use 12-point, non-boldface, regular type for the Author. Add the symbol "*" for the corresponding author of the abstract. Use 10-point, italics for the Affiliation. Include organization, address, city, state or province, postal code and country. Include e-mail address, if available. Leave a 24-point space after the last author's information, and write the word "ABSTRACT" in 12 point, boldface, capital letters. Leave 24 point space after the word, and write the content in one-column using 10 point font.

The abstract body text uses the distributed alignment, as shown here. Preferably, use three paragraphs to separate the body text: (1) introduction and objective of the research/paper, (2) methods and techniques of investigation, and (3) important outcomes, expectations or conclusion. Leave a 6-point space after the body text. Provide 3 keywords that reflect the content of the abstract. Write the corresponding author's contact information at the end of the abstract. Submit the abstract in MS Word in either format – document (.doc) or rich text format (.rtf). Accepted abstracts will be used in the full paper to be published as proceedings by the IEA Press.

Download an abstract template from the Congress website at www.iea2009.org. Replace the text in the template and save the file as: "LastnameFirstname_date.doc" (e.g. ZhangKan_071008.doc). The date details the day, month and year of submission. If more than one abstract is submitted by the same author, differentiate each abstract by adding numbers after the name (e.g. ZhangKan1_date.doc). Submit your abstract on the website of IEA2009.
